



## Financial Assistance Policy

JScreen is a non-profit, community-based public health initiative dedicated to preventing Jewish genetic diseases. Through the generosity of our donors, we are able to subsidize the cost of testing for eligible individuals who meet the financial assistance criteria.

Our Financial Assistance Program offers subsidies for men and women between the ages of 18-45 who also meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Those who are uninsured and are unable to pay the self-pay price for testing.
- Those who have insurance, but whose family incomes meet the following criteria:

No. of Persons in Family	Qualifying Annual Family Income*
1	\$34,470 or less
2	\$46,530 or less
3	\$58,590 or less
4	\$70,650 or less
5	\$82,710 or less
<b>For families with more than 5 persons, add \$8,040 for each additional person. *300 percent more than the Federal poverty guideline.</b>	

- Those who have insurance, a partner who has tested positive for at least one of the diseases on the screening panels AND who needs financial assistance.
- Other extenuating circumstances to be determined by JScreen's third-party financial assistance administrator.
